K9 Handler Equipment list

- Police Dog and K9 unit
- Uniform and Duty Gear
- Duty weapon and 150 rounds of handgun ammo
- Vest, Tactical Vest and Helmet
- Flashlights
- Muzzle
- Patrol, 30, 50 foot leash
- Collars (e, pinch, 1.5-2 inch flat, choke/fur saver)
- Harness/Vest (load bearing)
- Large cotton balls/mutt muffs
- Gas Masks (if needed for planned evolutions)
- Eyes and Ear protection
- First Aid Equipment for K9
- Elbow and Knee Pads (if needed)
- Break Bar
- Reward toy

Equipment for SWAT Operators

- SWAT Vehicle with your equipment (Optional)
- SWAT Uniform
- Vest, Tactical Vest and Helmet
- Flashlights
- Gas Mask (if needed for planned evolutions)
- Eyes and Ear Protection
- Ballistic Shield and Mirror
- Elbow and Knee Pads
- Radio Communications (Optional)
- One Flash Bang - EDD per person
- Large amounts of drinking water
- Duty weapon with approx 100 rounds of handgun ammo and shoulder weapon with approx 250 rounds of ammo
- Less lethal and required training rounds (Bean Bag, Pepper Ball, Taser, etc)
